Thank you very much for your fantastic donation of £250.00 received on 08/02/2011 for the Surrey Air Ambulance. In 2010, we flew 1397 missions and your support will ensure that our life-saving helicopter will continue to help people like Tony, whose story is below.

Tony McCormack was driving to work when he was involved in a very serious road traffic accident. He recalls very little about the accident but remembers hearing a 'loud bang' when he was involved in a collision with another car. Tony was trapped and unable to move.

The Air Ambulance was at the scene within five minutes and our medical team of a doctor and paramedic set to work immediately. Tony had suffered multiple fractures and the team was very concerned about the state of his right leg in particular. It took two hours to extract Tony from the wreckage and he was then flown directly to hospital where he went straight into surgery for many hours.

Tony stayed in hospital for three weeks and then embarked on a lengthy rehabilitation programme. A year after his accident, Tony was able to visit the airbase to personally thank the crew that saved him that day.

It was not just the saving of time that made all this possible but the skill and dedication of the team that treated Tony at the scene throughout his lengthy extraction and then in the air until arrival at an appropriate hospital.
